31st Great Nundle Dog Race

Originally held to settle a dispute between two farmers over whose working dog was fastest, this renowned annual event is held on the first Sunday in May at the Nundle Recreation Reserve.

A terrific family day out, the major fundraiser for the P&C Ass. has lots of fun activities and races for both dogs and humans. Enjoy delicious refreshments while watching the hilarious antics of dogs and owners as they race to win great prizes. A raffle, souvenirs, and children's entertainment add to the excitement of the day.

Check out the different categories of races for your dog. The feature race is, of course, The Great Nundle Dog Race for working sheep and cattle dogs.

Rules & Race Information

- All entrants must have an entry ticket to participate in a race. Tickets are available from the Entry Tent near announcers' truck.
- All participants must adhere to the race rules or be disqualified.
- All races are of 100 metres unless stated otherwise, starting at the official starting line and finishing at the finish line.
- Dogs are held at the starting line by a handler. They run to their owner or catcher who calls the dog from behind the finish line.
- Only one catcher per dog allowed at the finish line.
- The dog that crosses the finishing line first will be declared the winner, irrespective of the route taken or the fights entered into.
- No artificial aids (eg. whistles, balls, toys, food, small children) to be used by either handler or catcher to call or entice the dog. Catchers may verbally call or mouth whistle their dogs.
- The Judge's decision is final.
- Prizes may be claimed after 1.30pm from the prize room next to the canteen. Please produce your winner's ticket for proof of claim.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter, or vary the order of, events listed on the program at any time.

The Great Nundle Dog Race: to be eligible to enter, the dog is to be a bona fide working dog and is not to enter any other dog race on the day. They may enter the Doggy High Jump and the Best Dressed Dog Fashion Parade. An entry form for the GNDR must be completed at the Entry Tent.

Whippet and Greyhound breeds: these dogs may only enter the Whippet/Greyhound Race, Juvenile Whippet/Greyhound Stakes, Junior Dog on a Leash, Doggy High Jump and the Best Dressed Dog Fashion Parade.

Program of Events

Please note that prizes are claimed after 1.30pm from the prize room next to the canteen.
Please produce your winner's ticket for proof of claim.

10.30am Junior Dog on a Leash (\$3)

7 yrs & under; 8 yrs & under 13 yrs. Children run from start to finish with their dog on a leash. Prizes kindly donated by the Guide Dogs Association of NSW.

10.45am Children's Age Races 50m (Free entry)

Under 6 yrs; 6 & under 8 yrs; 8 & under 13 yrs.
No spikes to be worn.

11.00am Stumpy's Dog Derby (\$5)

Dogs chase a fox skin around a circular enclosure. Small, medium and large dogs sections. Heats are followed by a final. Pay at event to enter your dog.

11.00am Nundle Saw Mill Gladiator (\$5)

No bikinis allowed! A test of speed & agility against other warrior dogs to the top of a mountain of hay bales. Small, medium and large dogs sections. Pay at event to enter.

11.00am Large House Dog Derby (\$3)

Large dogs measuring over 30cm. Measurement of your dog taken at entry tent. Prizes donated by Weatherbeeta.

11.20am Small House Dog Derby (\$3)

Small dogs measuring 30cm or under. Measurement of your dog taken at entry tent. Prizes kindly donated by Cobba Dog Coats.

11.30am Words of Welcome

"Advance Australia Fair" and "Acknowledgment to Country" performed by Nundle Public School children.

11.30am Doggy High Jump (\$3)

Dogs jump over high jump installed on the back of a ute. Elimination rounds. **No entries permitted after first elimination round.** No artificial aids (eg. whistles, food) or helping hand or foot may be used to encourage the dog to jump. All dogs eligible to enter. Prizes kindly donated by Weatherbeeta.

11.45am Steeplechase (\$3)

Dogs race over hay bale jumps. **Small** dogs 30cm or under; **large** dogs over 30cm. Heats followed by a final. Measurement of your dog taken at entry tent.

12.15pm The Duck and Dog Show

Local man Mr. Pat O'Hearn will delight the audience with his well trained ducks, dogs and pony in an amazing display of animal obedience.

12.35pm Best Dressed Dog Fashion Parade (\$3)

Any fashion goes! 12 and under; over 12 years. Assemble outside gate near announcer's truck. Spectators to please remain outside the fence.

1.00pm Great Nundle Dog Race 2010 Heats (\$10)

The first four dogs in each heat go through to the final at 3.15pm. Dogs are to be registered at the Entry Tent before participating. Please refer to Rules on this program for more information.

1.30pm Mixed Sack Races for Children 50m (\$3)

8 yrs & under; 9 & under 12 yrs; 13 & under 17yrs.

1.40pm Whippet/Greyhound Race (\$3)

Only whippet and greyhound breeds to enter this race.

1.50pm Juvenile Canine Stakes (\$3)

12 yrs & under; 13 & under 18 yrs. Handler starts dog at starting line and child calls dog from finish line.

2.05pm Juvenile Whippet/Greyhound Stakes (\$3)

Under 18 yrs. Whippets and greyhounds only. Handler starts dog at starting line and child calls dog from finish line.

2.15pm Novelty Dog on a Leash (\$3)

Handler starts dog which runs to catcher at finish line. Catcher leashes dog behind the finish line, then both run back to start line. Dogs leashed prematurely will be disqualified. Prizes kindly donated by Weatherbeeta.

2.30pm RSPCA Mongrel Invitation Stakes (\$3)

All breeds, excluding greyhounds & whippets. Heats are run depending on number of entries, followed by a final. Trophy supplied by RSPCA. Prizes donated by Horseland.

3.15pm Great Nundle Dog Race 2010 Final

Prizes kindly donated by Weatherbeeta. Trophy mug given by Tamworth Trophy Supplies. Collar and lead donated by Hiscock's Saddlery, Tamworth.

3.30pm Consolation Event (\$5)

For dogs (excluding whippets and greyhounds) not placed first, second or third in any race during the day. One race only ie. no heats. Entries taken from 2.30pm at the Entry Tent. Prizes kindly donated by Weatherbeeta.
