Market Stall Rules and Conditions and Application Form

RULES and CONDITIONS

Application to hold a stall: All bookings for stalls must be on the Festival Committee's application form. The form which is an integral part of these rules must be signed. Completed application forms, insurance documentation and payment must be in the hands of the Market Stall Administrator by 1st April, 2012. The address is PO Box 8098, Nundle, NSW, 2340

Site Fees

Craft, Produce etc. The site fees have been set as follows and cover attendance on both days. There is no reduction for a one day attendance. GST is included

4m x 4m site	\$ 80
6m x 4m site	\$100
8m x 4m site	\$120

Fees for sites larger than those stated in these conditions will be determined by the Festival Committee and charged accordingly.

Hot Food: The site fees for hot food stalls have been set at

6m x 4m site	\$200
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Fees for sites larger than those stated in these conditions will be assessed by the Festival Committee and charged accordingly.

Refunds will only be made if the event is cancelled.

Public Liability Insurance: A requirement of Tamworth Regional Council is that all stallholders must have Public Liability insurance cover. The certificate of currency which **must be provided with the application** to hold a stall must be for at least \$10,000,000 cover. Food stalls and activities which involve the public, such as rides, jumping castles and the like must have at least \$20,000,000 cover. The certificate must be for the correct type of insurance for the activity undertaken. No stallholder can set up in any Council street or park without this documentation being supplied to the Stalls Coordinator. Applications without a correct certificate attached will not be accepted.

Positioning of Sites: Sites for stalls will be along Jenkins and Oakenville Streets including the median strip, the area on the southern side of the swimming pool with limited sites in Captain Cook Park. Stallholders are to be aware that the areas offered may change each year. The final decision in positioning of stalls will be made by the Market Stall Coordinator and the Go for Gold Festival Committee. The Festival Committee does not supply shade shelters (eg umbrellas, gazebos etc), chairs, tables or trestles.

Set Up and Take Down: The set up period is between 6.30a.m. and 8.30a.m. each day. Stall holders are to report to the Market Stall Coordinator (at the Gazebo, corner Oakenville St and Jenkins St) prior to setting up, to obtain stall position. No stall holder is to set up without instructions from the Coordinator or his/her appointed representative. Take down for stalls each day is 4.00p.m. The Festival Committee personnel will not be available to direct stall holders to sites before 6.30 a.m. on either day unless prior arrangements have been made.

Australian National Food Standards: Stallholders selling packaged foods - e.g. jams, cakes etc. and hot foods must comply with the rules of the Australian National Food Standards and the Tamworth Regional Council Health Department in regard to labelling and food handling.

Power: The Festival Committee and The Tamworth Regional Council do not and cannot arrange for the supply of electricity, electrical cords or testing and certification of cords and appliances. If electricity is sourced from local businesses etc. all electrical leads and electrical appliances used by the stallholder must carry current certification/testing tags and comply with the necessary Occupational Health and Safety Regulations. Generators must be able to run quietly.

Camping on site: It is a Tamworth Regional Council condition of approval for the Festival that stallholders do not sleep or camp on their stall site overnight.

Responsibility for Damage: Stall holders will be liable for any damage caused to grounds, streets, buildings or property of Tamworth Regional Council.

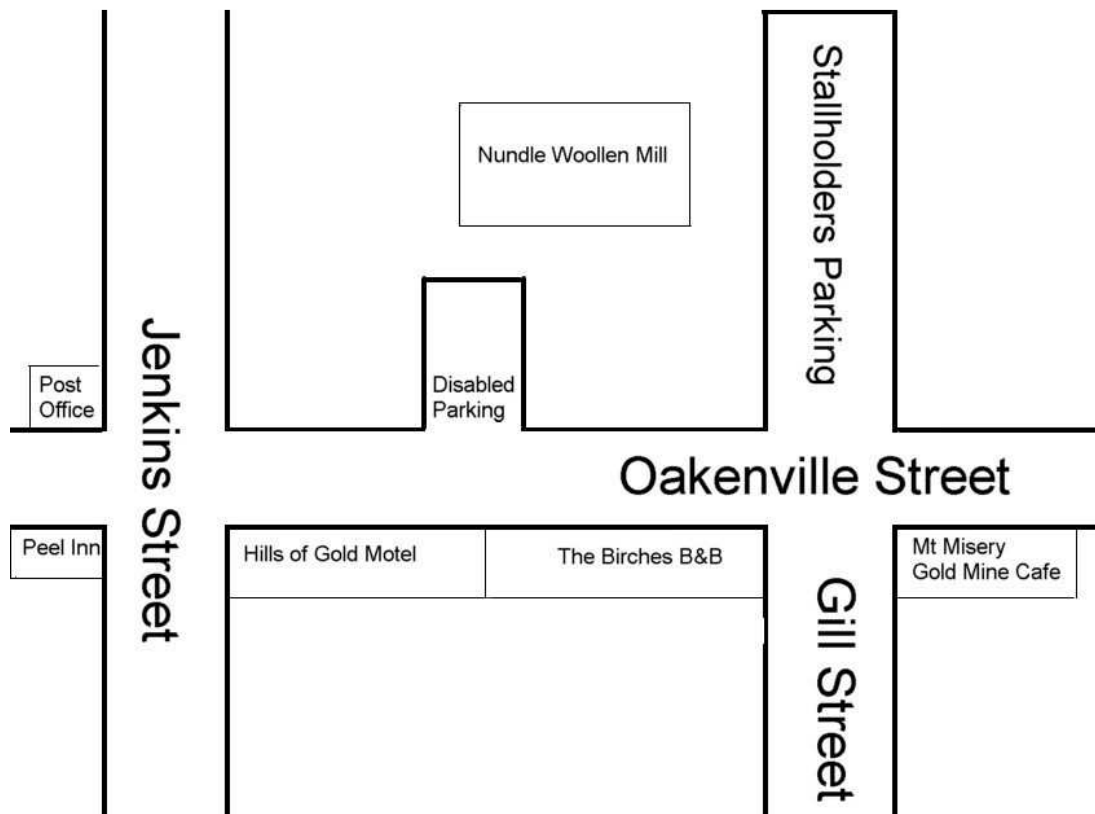
Removal of Rubbish: Rubbish bins are provided throughout the town. Stallholders are asked to keep their sites clean and tidy throughout the day and on vacating the site at the end of each day.

Security: Security is the responsibility of the stall holder at all times. There is no organised overnight security.

Disputes: In the event of a dispute, the Executive of the Festival Committee will mediate and the decision of the Committee will be final.

Stallholders' parking: Nundle's main streets are closed to traffic between 8.30am and 4.00pm. All stallholders' vehicles are to be moved from the set-up site as soon as possible. Refer to the map for the parking area which has been reserved for stallholders. The disabled parking area is only for vehicles displaying the proper permit.
